FROM THE DESK OF CITY MANAGER REESE GOAD



In 2024, the City of Tallahassee celebrated its bicentennial with remarkable achievements, marking 200 years of rich history, growth, and community spirit. From vibrant cultural events to impactful projects that enhanced infrastructure and quality of life, this milestone year showcased the best of Tallahassee. We tackled new challenges with innovation and resilience, consistently delivering best-in-class services, even in the face of unprecedented events and natural disasters.

Delivering on our mission, vision, and values was especially evident during disaster responses. We continue to set the standard for natural disaster response and recovery as clearly demonstrated on May 10, when the City was hit by multiple EF-2 tornadoes. Destruction to our electric grid was extensive with over 500 broken poles and 325 damaged transformers, leaving more than 80,000 customers without power and requiring a complete rebuild of significant portions of the system. Within just two days of the tornadoes, the City had restored 91% of the electric grid. The unprecedented damage and community-wide costs exceeded those of Hurricanes Hermine, Irma, and Michael combined, resulting in an estimated \$50 million in damages and recovery costs to the City.

This year marks the final year of our 2020-2024 strategic plan. Over 90% of current strategic plan targets have been completed. Using the strategic plan as a guide, the City's focused efforts, including significant investments in its infrastructure, have created a robust economic environment, promoting smart growth and development that attracts businesses and investors. As a result, Tallahassee has the Strongest Economy in the U.S. according to Area Development, a national site-selection industry magazine.

To help move Tallahassee forward and keep costs low for residents, we set a goal five years ago to increase annual grant awards to better leverage available resources that complement local tax dollars. Through our aggressive approach to identify and apply for competitive state and federal grants, we have brought over \$300 million to our community since 2020, which exceeds the total amount of property taxes received by the City during the same period!

A key contributor to the local economy, Tallahassee International Airport generates an estimated \$1 billion economic impact annually. The City's airport serves as a critical gateway for business travel, tourism, and cargo operations, and by the end of the year, nearly 1 million passengers will have passed through its modernized terminal. Completion of the international processing facility, which is under construction, will further position Tallahassee as a growing hub for global connections and business. The airport's planned designation as the hub of an eleven county Foreign Trade Zone will further boost its economic impact and regional competitiveness.

Additionally, the City made progress this year on transformative projects that will enhance economic, educational, and leisure opportunities, as well as safety, for residents. Construction is underway on the Southside Transit Center, second senior center, and headquarters for the Tallahassee Police Department (TPD), to name a few.

The prioritization of investing in TPD has proven effective, as evidenced by a recent reduction in violent crime. Over the past year, violent crime has decreased by approximately 14%, with an even more substantial decline of 30% during the summer months. This improvement highlights the success of holistic public safety strategies for fostering a safer environment for all residents.

As 2024 ends, the City of Tallahassee celebrates its many accomplishments that have significantly advanced our mission and strategic priorities. These achievements are a testament to the power of teamwork, with staff working together seamlessly to enhance the quality of life for residents and address key areas. Through this spirit of collaboration, we have made meaningful progress, fostering a stronger, safer, and more resilient community. The following pages highlight the outcomes of our collective efforts and the impact we've made together.

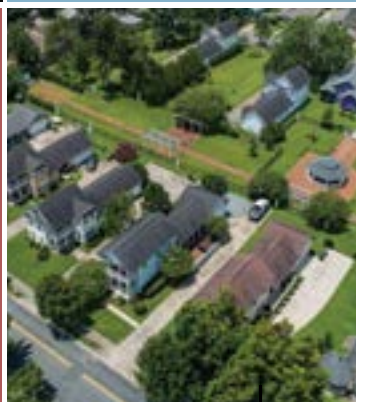

Highlights 2024

- Invested more than \$267 million in capital projects, enhancing community connectivity, resilience, and quality of life through improvements in transportation, utilities, and public safety.
- Reached the milestone of 100 parks, expanding the City's world-class park system that includes more than 4,000 acres of parkland and 80 miles of trails, thus ensuring every City resident lives within a 10-minute walk to a park or green space.
- Started construction of a second Senior Center to meet the needs of the City's growing senior population, providing more dedicated space for recreational, social, and educational activities. This additional center will promote healthy aging, community engagement, and overall well-being.
- Supported the design/construction of 14 Greenways Master Plan Projects representing over 37 miles of greenways.
- Earned Tree City USA designation for the 32nd consecutive year highlighting the City's long-standing commitment to urban forestry and environmental stewardship. This recognition underscores the City's dedication to maintaining a healthy, vibrant tree canopy, which improves air quality, provides shade, and enhances the overall quality of life for residents.
- Planted over 2,000 trees, further enhancing the urban canopy, which covers 55% of the landscape, and contributing to a healthier and even more beautiful community.
- Enhanced FAMU Way with a History and Culture Trail that celebrates local history and civil rights.
- Secured a \$25,000 Urban and Community Forestry grant to support the health and management of the urban forest for future generations.
- Place new National Register of Historic Places marker at Jake Gaither Golf Course.
- Honored trailblazing tennis champion and civil rights icon Althea Gibson, by renaming a prominent street to celebrate her legacy.
- Coordinated and supported numerous events that foster community spirit.



Quality Of Life

Residents of Tallahassee enjoy an exceptional quality of life, anchored by the City's top-notch delivery of municipal services. Reliable utilities, affordable housing options on the rise, and a thriving economy—ranked the strongest in the U.S.—make Tallahassee an attractive place to live.

Each neighborhood, with its rich history and unique identity, reflects the City's dedication to community resilience and well-being. Smart planning has enhanced the natural beauty of the city, with one of the highest percentages of canopy coverage in the nation at 55%, creating a lush environment. Nearly 100 percent of residents live within a 10-minute walk to a park or green space, and the world-class park system promotes active, healthy lifestyles with miles of trails and abundant recreational opportunities.

Tallahassee's educational opportunities are equally impressive, with several higher-ed institutions contributing to a well-educated workforce and robust job market. The vibrant arts and culture scene, filled with renowned festivals, performances, and galleries, further enhances the community's vibrancy and creativity.

Through its combined focus on affordable living, environmental stewardship, and economic growth, Tallahassee continues to prosper and provide a fulfilling, thriving life for its residents.



Economic Development

To advance as a competitive, innovative and sustainable regional economic hub

Highlights 2024

- Earned top spots including #1 in Economic Strength, #2 in Top Mid-Sized Metro Locations, #4 in the Top South Atlantic Region, and #9 in the Top 50 Metro Locations nationwide in a report published by Area Development magazine.
- Launched the Northeast Gateway: Welaunee Boulevard project in line with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan to advance regional mobility, support sustainable growth, and protect green space, creating a more connected and vibrant community. Efforts are anticipated to spur significant investment back into the community and are supported by \$4 million in Florida Department of Transportation grant funds.
- Issued permits for 1,460,112 square feet of commercial space.
- Issued 416 commercial permits with a total listed project valuation of more than \$544 million.
- Maintained an unemployment rate of 3.3%, consistent with the State average.
- Increased employed individuals by 4,400 between June 2023 and June 2024.
- Increased Tallahassee International Airport's economic contribution from \$399 million in 2014 to nearly \$1 billion.
- Increased passenger traffic from June 2023 to June 2024, reflecting a 12% average monthly increase of passengers from the previous year.
- Secured \$726,484 through the U.S. Department of Transportation's FAA Fiscal Year 2024 Airport Infrastructure Grants program to support the Terminal Modernization project, improving the passenger experience and airport facilities.
- Continued construction of the International Processing Facility and planned Foreign Trade Zone, which are expected to create over 1,600 jobs and generate more than \$300 million in annual economic impact.
- Partnered to secure a \$10 million investment in fueling and hangar facilities on 7.77 acres, which is anticipated to generate over \$9 million in lease revenue.

Public Infrastructure

To be a leading publicly owned utility and a city with efficient, well-connected public transit and infrastructure that supports a growing, progressive community

Highlights 2024

- Broke ground on the new Southside Transit Center, second senior center and new police headquarters.
- Invested \$61 million in the wastewater collection system including Pump Station #182 Rehabilitation, which enhances redundancy and resiliency for one of the City's largest pump stations, and Capital Circle Southeast Force Main Rehabilitation, which increases system reliability and resiliency and extends the service life of the pipeline, which is responsible for 40% of the City's daily wastewater flow.
- Earned \$10 million in Water Quality Improvement grant funds from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to support the Southside Triangle Septic to Sewer initiative.
- Invested \$19.5 million to enhance the potable water system, upgrading essential infrastructure to ensure a high-quality water supply for residents.
- Secured \$1.8 million in Florida Department of Environmental Protection grant funds for the Southside Triangle water/sewer project to support critical improvements to these systems.
- Awarded \$550,000 from the Florida Department of Transportation for Blair Stone Road and New Village Avenue safety improvements and infrastructure upgrades.
- Completed permitting and awarded a contract for construction of Phase 1 of the Lake Jackson Greenway project to create a 5.1-mile multi-modal connection between Lake Ella and Lake Jackson Mounds Archaeological State Park.
- Awarded \$11.3 million grant from the Federal Transit Administration for eight electric buses, expanded charging infrastructure, and workforce development programs for the growing electric fleet.

Public Infrastructure

The City of Tallahassee is dedicated to investing in public infrastructure to enhance the quality of life for its residents. In 2024, the City embarked on several significant construction projects that demonstrate its commitment to improving community services and resources. These include the construction of a new police headquarters, a second senior center, and a Southside transit center, each designed to meet the growing needs of Tallahassee's diverse population.

The new police headquarters marks a critical investment in public safety. This modern facility will enhance the capacity of the Tallahassee Police Department, providing advanced technology and space for officers to serve the community more effectively. This initiative reflects the City's focus on safety, preparedness, and fostering positive community relationships.

Additionally, the construction of a new senior center will address the needs of Tallahassee's aging population. This facility will provide a space for seniors to engage in social, recreational, and educational activities, helping to improve their quality of life and well-being. It underscores the City's commitment to creating inclusive spaces for all residents.

The Southside Transit Center is a major infrastructure project that when completed will offer enhanced transit access, promoting mobility and connectivity for Southside residents, which will support economic development and access to essential services.

These are just a few of the key projects that reflect the City of Tallahassee's strategic approach to infrastructure development, ensuring that future growth is met with the necessary facilities to support a vibrant and thriving community.



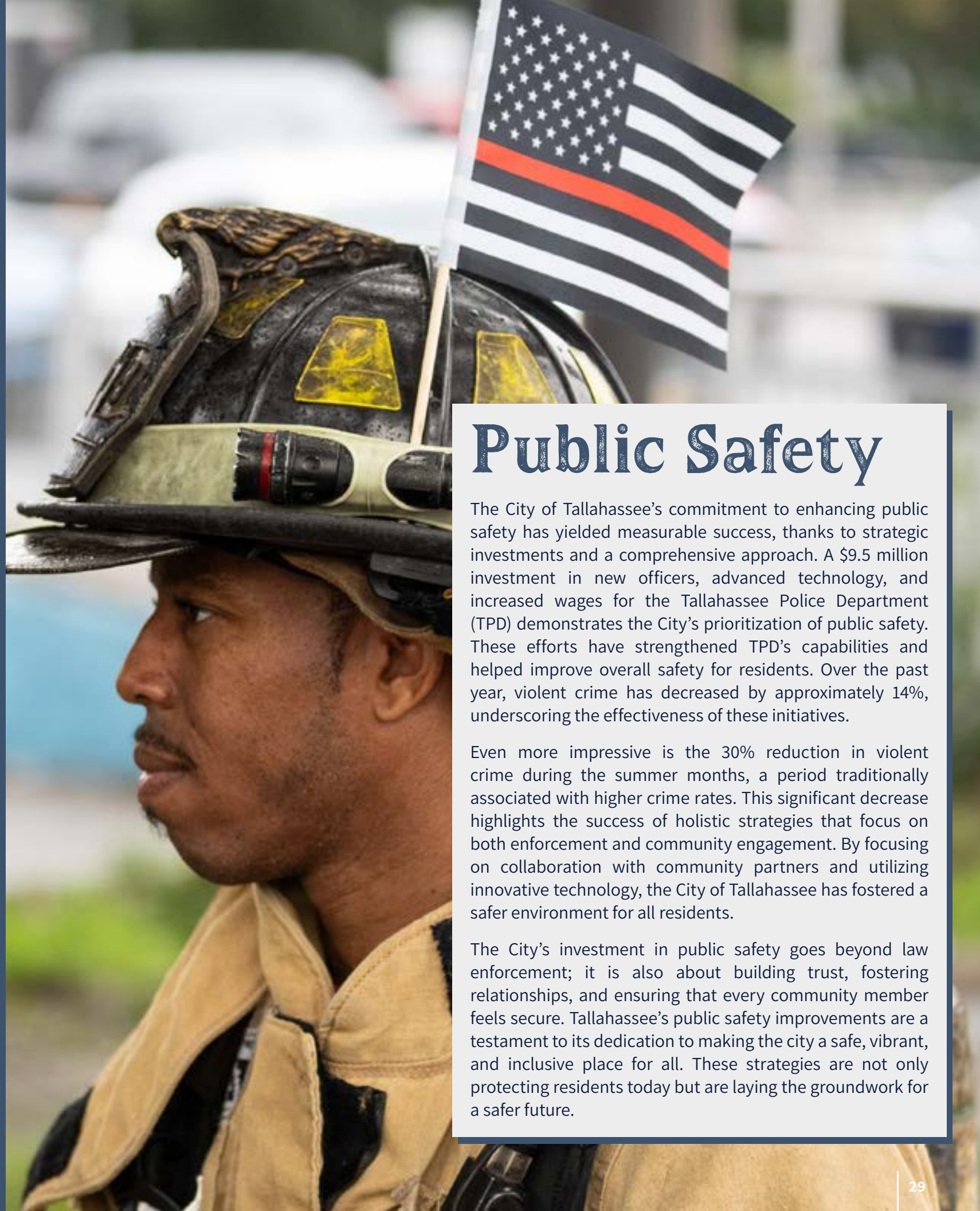


Public Safety

To be a safe, resilient and inclusive community

Highlights 2024

- Engaged more than 100 neighborhoods in Neighborhood Watch, strengthening community safety and vigilance.
- Conducted 243 community-oriented policing activities, enhancing local engagement and crime prevention.
- Invested \$19.2 million in community-led safety initiatives, including Neighborhood First to support comprehensive safety and community resilience.
- Awarded \$390,000 in Gun Violence Intervention funding from the Community Human Service Partnership (CHSP) allocation to support violence reduction efforts.
- Continued implementation and adoption of FBI - National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS) for a more accurate reflection of crime statistics, as well as public access and awareness of crime data. NIBRS data analysis supports crime prevention techniques and more effective policing.
- Achieved 39.5 hours of mandatory training per police officer, ensuring compliance with professional development requirements.
- Coordinated 564 hours of emergency preparedness training focused on preparedness, response, recovery, and practical exercises.
- Trained over 700 first responders, partners, stakeholders, and community members, enhancing emergency response capabilities.
- Facilitated or participated in 12 exercises with response agencies and partners, including eight tabletop exercises, three drills, and one full-scale exercise, to improve coordination and readiness.
- Assisted with over 7,000 calls for service, queried over 17,000 subjects, checked more than 18,000 vehicles, and helped recover over 150 stolen vehicles through the Capital Region Real-Time Crime Center.
- Introduced National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) technology to combat gun violence and examined 1,235 ballistic casings, 261 firearms, and 479 NIBIN entries, generating 92 case leads.
- Coordinated Readiness and Emergency Preparedness (PREP) workshops for citizens in preparation for hurricane season.



Public Safety

The City of Tallahassee's commitment to enhancing public safety has yielded measurable success, thanks to strategic investments and a comprehensive approach. A \$9.5 million investment in new officers, advanced technology, and increased wages for the Tallahassee Police Department (TPD) demonstrates the City's prioritization of public safety. These efforts have strengthened TPD's capabilities and helped improve overall safety for residents. Over the past year, violent crime has decreased by approximately 14%, underscoring the effectiveness of these initiatives.

Even more impressive is the 30% reduction in violent crime during the summer months, a period traditionally associated with higher crime rates. This significant decrease highlights the success of holistic strategies that focus on both enforcement and community engagement. By focusing on collaboration with community partners and utilizing innovative technology, the City of Tallahassee has fostered a safer environment for all residents.

The City's investment in public safety goes beyond law enforcement; it is also about building trust, fostering relationships, and ensuring that every community member feels secure. Tallahassee's public safety improvements are a testament to its dedication to making the city a safe, vibrant, and inclusive place for all. These strategies are not only protecting residents today but are laying the groundwork for a safer future.

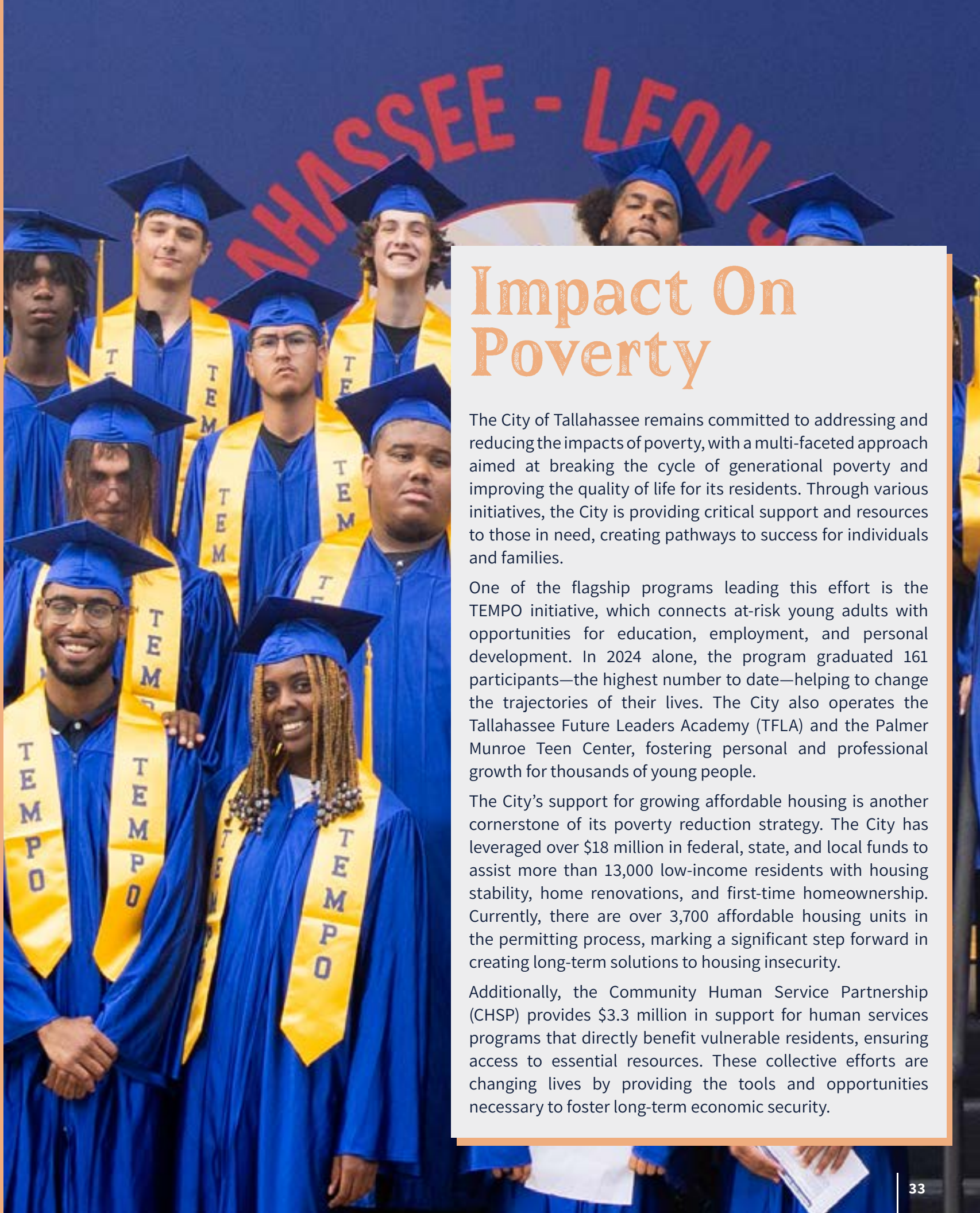


Impact on Poverty

To be a leading partner connecting residents to resources that remove economic and social barriers

Highlights 2024

- Continued funding for wrap-around public safety programs, including \$1.8 million for the Tallahassee Engaged in Meaningful Productivity for Opportunity (TEMPO) program.
- Graduated 161 formerly at-risk students through TEMPO, marking the highest graduate number in the program's history.
- Invested \$290,000 for the Tallahassee Future Leaders Academy (TFLA).
- Increased participation at the Palmer Munroe Teen Center to 23,411 participants, reflecting a 20% increase over last year.
- Supported over 13,000 low-income residents in staying in their homes, carrying out essential renovations, and purchasing homes for the first time.
- Continued leveraging more than \$18 million from federal, state, and local sources to address affordable housing, with more affordable housing projects in the pipeline than in the last 25 years combined.
- Assessed 60 properties across the city, including 20 in the South Monroe Corridor, to identify and address community needs, promote effective urban planning, and support housing development. Another seven properties along Wallis Street and Meridian Road were assessed specifically for affordable housing.
- Issued permits for 42 multi-family buildings, resulting in 1,143 new dwelling units.
- 3,700 affordable housing units are currently in the permitting process.
- Provided \$700,000 in funding for the Tallahassee Emergency Assessment Mobile (TEAM) unit to support the City's long-term strategic priority of building a safe, resilient, and inclusive community.
- Responded to 1,898 non-violent mental health calls through the TEAM unit.
- Invested \$3.3 million in human services programs with a proven record of success through the Community Human Service Partnership (CHSP).



Impact On Poverty

The City of Tallahassee remains committed to addressing and reducing the impacts of poverty, with a multi-faceted approach aimed at breaking the cycle of generational poverty and improving the quality of life for its residents. Through various initiatives, the City is providing critical support and resources to those in need, creating pathways to success for individuals and families.

One of the flagship programs leading this effort is the TEMPO initiative, which connects at-risk young adults with opportunities for education, employment, and personal development. In 2024 alone, the program graduated 161 participants—the highest number to date—helping to change the trajectories of their lives. The City also operates the Tallahassee Future Leaders Academy (TFLA) and the Palmer Munroe Teen Center, fostering personal and professional growth for thousands of young people.

The City's support for growing affordable housing is another cornerstone of its poverty reduction strategy. The City has leveraged over \$18 million in federal, state, and local funds to assist more than 13,000 low-income residents with housing stability, home renovations, and first-time homeownership. Currently, there are over 3,700 affordable housing units in the permitting process, marking a significant step forward in creating long-term solutions to housing insecurity.

Additionally, the Community Human Service Partnership (CHSP) provides \$3.3 million in support for human services programs that directly benefit vulnerable residents, ensuring access to essential resources. These collective efforts are changing lives by providing the tools and opportunities necessary to foster long-term economic security.

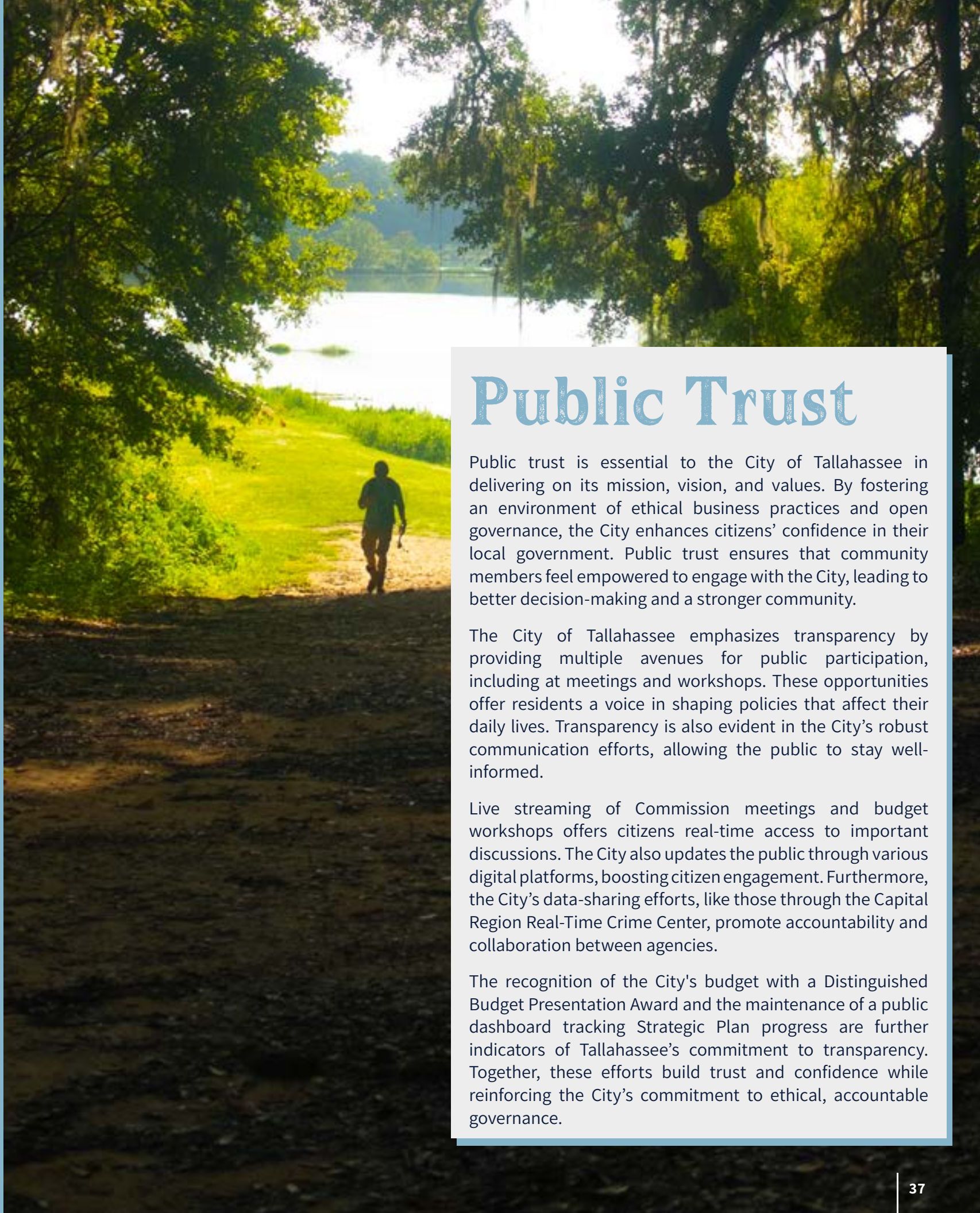


Public Trust

To enhance public trust through ethical business practices and transparent governance

Highlights 2024

- Provided multiple opportunities for community input and participation on the fiscal year budget and the 2025-2029 strategic plan by holding a total of three workshops.
- Continued data sharing between agencies through the Capital Region Real-Time Crime Center and provided direct access to the partner agencies' record management systems.
- Streamed live meetings (e.g., Commission meetings and budget workshops) and programs, enabling real-time access and viewership by thousands of citizens.
- Updated the Strategic Plan public dashboard regularly with progress toward targets and initiatives.
- Recognized with a GFOA Distinguished Budget Presentation Award for the City's budget, receiving approximately 1.9 million visitors (3% increase) and over 9 million pageviews (5% increase) this year.
- Grew X (Twitter) engagement by 71%, post link clicks by 36%, and followers by 10%.
- Increased Instagram engagement by 18%, engagement rate by 16%, and followers by 12%.
- Increased LinkedIn activity by 34%, engagement rate by 16%, and post link clicks by 41%.
- Produced more than 66 videos and 57 shorts on YouTube, generating 61,563 views (up 46%), with total video views reaching 152,157 from September 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, with subscribers increasing by 40%, nearing 6,000.
- Streamed 48 City Commission meetings and events on WCOT, Talgov.com, and social media accounts.



Public Trust

Public trust is essential to the City of Tallahassee in delivering on its mission, vision, and values. By fostering an environment of ethical business practices and open governance, the City enhances citizens' confidence in their local government. Public trust ensures that community members feel empowered to engage with the City, leading to better decision-making and a stronger community.

The City of Tallahassee emphasizes transparency by providing multiple avenues for public participation, including at meetings and workshops. These opportunities offer residents a voice in shaping policies that affect their daily lives. Transparency is also evident in the City's robust communication efforts, allowing the public to stay well-informed.

Live streaming of Commission meetings and budget workshops offers citizens real-time access to important discussions. The City also updates the public through various digital platforms, boosting citizen engagement. Furthermore, the City's data-sharing efforts, like those through the Capital Region Real-Time Crime Center, promote accountability and collaboration between agencies.

The recognition of the City's budget with a Distinguished Budget Presentation Award and the maintenance of a public dashboard tracking Strategic Plan progress are further indicators of Tallahassee's commitment to transparency. Together, these efforts build trust and confidence while reinforcing the City's commitment to ethical, accountable governance.

Organizational Effectiveness

To be an impact-focused workforce that is inclusive, pioneering and technology-driven

Highlights 2024

- Recognized by Diversity Comm Magazine as a Top Diverse Employer, Top Black Employer, and Top Women Employer.
- Implemented a 4.2% across-the-board raise for general employees for FY25 to align with the commitment to competitive compensation and attracting and retaining top talent.
- Grew participation in the New Public Servant Initiative (NPSI) cohort to 29 participants, representing a 61% increase from the previous year and demonstrating the program's expanding impact and success in employee development.
- Continued partnership with FSU to send eligible supervisors to the Certified Public Manager (CPM) program to support the professional development of City supervisors and enhance management skills.
- Received the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association for the 37th year in a row, which highlights the City's transparent and effective budgeting practices and unwavering commitment to financial stability and sound budgeting principles.
- Achieved an 80% "outstanding" rating from the GFOA, significantly surpassing the target of 25%.
- Received an Unmodified Opinion for the FY2023 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR), with no new findings or management letter comments. This "clean audit" is the highest standard of achievement for external audits of government agencies.
- Achieved a 91.6% funded ratio for the general employee pension plan.
- Maintained best-in-class municipal "AA" Bond rating from Moody's, S&P, and Fitch credit rating agencies.
- Awarded a Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting from GFOA.
- Met 100% of Growth Management's seven-day initial review and five-day resubmittal review deadlines for new single-family and two-family residential permits as part of the Residential Guarantee Program, with an average review time of 2.33 days.

Destruction to the City's electric grid was extensive with over 500 broken poles and 325 damaged transformers, leaving more than 80,000 customers without power and requiring a complete rebuild of significant portions of the system. Within just two days of the tornadoes, the City had restored 91 percent of the electric grid. The unprecedented damage and community-wide costs exceeded those of Hurricanes Hermine, Irma, and Michael combined.

On September 26, Hurricane Helene made landfall as a Category 4 hurricane with 140mph winds approximately 57 miles southeast of Tallahassee. At peak, the storm left approximately 4.8 million customers without power across the southeastern U.S. While the storm shifted to our east just a few hours before landfall, roughly 50 percent of our community sustained a power outage and the grid was restored within 24 hours of the storm departing our area. Through preparation and teamwork, staff delivered a high level of service response to residents and offered mutual aid to our neighbors following our recovery. With an ongoing spirit of collaboration, staff remains committed to fostering an even stronger, safer, and more resilient community.

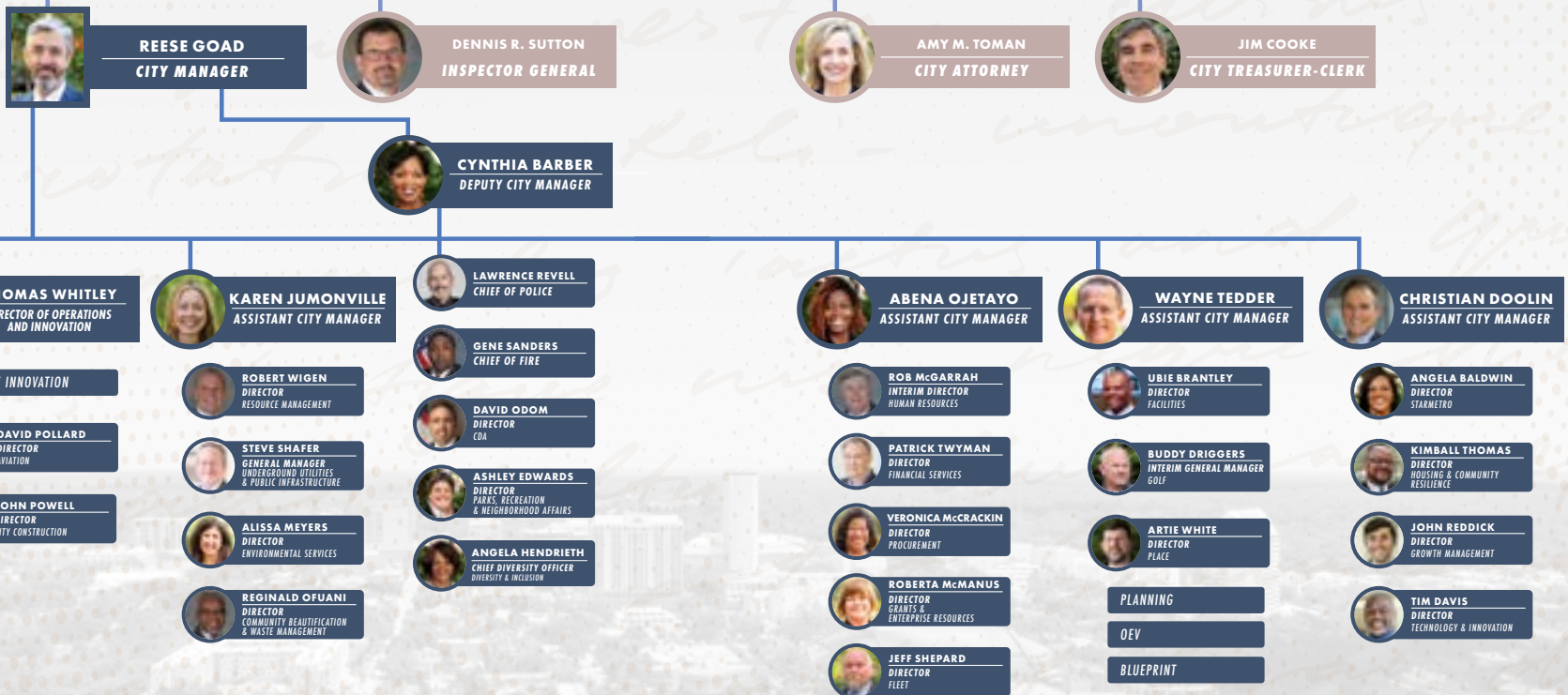
